Social Skills:-

Personal Hygiene:-

- Covering his/her nose & mouth when he/she coughs or sneezes.
- Avoid eating uncovered food.
- Avoid licking his/her finger or thumb.
- Keeping his/her hair lice free.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose, mouth, ears with dirty hands.
- Washing hands frequently.
- Teach your child to tie his/her shoes.
- Teach your child to button up his/her shirt.
- Make your child to learn to pack up his/her bag.
- Make your child to learn to eat food on his/her own.
