In case of emergency, sometimes the teacher has to take leaves during important times (like result etc.), some other teachers are allotted with your duties, so after your joining the duty it is your work to check the work done by others for any errors. Those errors must be intimated to concerned authorities for rectification on time,
- 12. Follow up the information already provided in planner.

ALL CLASS TEACHERS AND SUBJECT TEACHERS ARE INSTRUCTED TO DO THEIR WORK DILIGENTLY, HONESTLY AND WITH UTMOST CARE, SO THAT NO ERRORS ARE FOUND. THERE SHOULD NOT BE ANY CARELESS TOWARDS YOUR PROFESSION.
